

- · 2 Cups of vanilla yogurt
- Honey

- 1. Prepare the baking sheet: Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
- 2. Spread yogurt: Spread the vanilla yogurt evenly on the parchment paper to form a thin layer.
- 3. Add toppings: Sprinkle granola over the yogurt, then top with mixed berries.
- Drizzle honey: Drizzle honey over the top of the yogurt and berries for extra sweetness.
- 5. Freeze: Place the baking sheet in the freezer for at least 2-3 hours or until the yogurt is firm.
- 6. Break into pieces: Once frozen, break the bark into pieces and enjoy!


